In *Summoned by Bells* (1960), Betjeman recreates his personal past in richly-detailed poems. Because the poet was able to recreate so accurately the time and place of his own childhood, Mills attributed to Betjeman “an almost Proustian memory.” Walter Allen, writing in the *New York Times* Book Review, called *Summoned by Bells* an autobiography. But the collection, Allen explained, “can’t be judged simply as the equivalent of an autobiographical novel.
